## Artwork by Stephanie Gagnepain

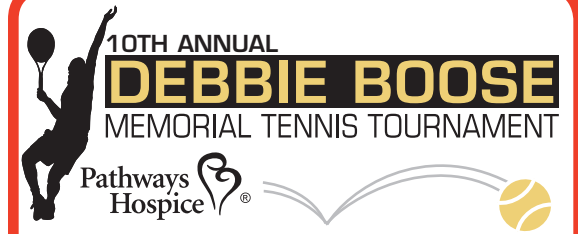
Since the tournament's inception, artwork for the awards has been donated by a local artist. Each award is printed or cast from an original piece of art work created by the artists specifically for the tournament.

## Conditions and Regulations

1. No entries will be accepted without full payment of fees. No fees refunded once draws are made.
2. Play will be governed by USTA rules, including the USTA authorized penalty system.
3. Players must report 15 minutes prior to match time ready to play. A default may be awarded 15 minutes after the match is called to court.
4. Warm-up time is 10 minutes, including serves.
5. Play will start at 5:00 p.m. Monday–Friday and will continue all day Saturday and Sunday beginning at 8:00 a.m. League conflicts will be accommodated if entered at league level. Start dates for certain events might vary. Call the Tournament Director at 970-412-5378 if you are concerned about conflicts.
6. **Players may enter a maximum of 2 events.**

*\*We appreciate your cooperation and flexibility with inclement weather. Every effort will be made to make up matches daily.*

## Tournament Format

A standard tournament draw with regular scoring, best two out of three sets with a match tie break (first to 10 points, win by 2) in lieu of a third set. Participants are guaranteed two matches. The consolation draw will be played out to completion. A round robin event may be scheduled in place of a standard draw if needed. Draws not meeting the minimum number of players may be canceled or combined. Refunds will be issued as appropriate.
