A CHARITABLE PLANNED GIVING SOCIETY**

**COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF NORTHERN COLORADO  
ISSUES \$70,000 MATCHING GIFT CHALLENGE**

FORT COLLINS/LOVELAND/WINDSOR - Hospice of Larimer County (HLC), a community-based, non-profit hospice care organization, recently announced the establishment of its *Enduring Legacy Society*. The *Enduring Legacy Society* was created in order to direct charitable donations to the agency's endowment via estate plans, bequests by will, retirement plan, remainder trust, gift annuity, life insurance, or other planned gifts.

The *Enduring Legacy Society* will offer HLC donors the ability to direct and focus their charitable gifts towards fulfilling personal objectives while securing the future of hospice care in their community. In 2007 alone, HLC provided hospice care to 943 patients and their family members and, supported and counseled more than 5,700 community members struggling with the loss of a loved one.

"As we look to the future, we are making the efforts necessary to ensure the sustainability of our organization and the services we provide", stated Evan Hyatt, Development and Marketing Executive for HLC. "In order to ensure our success, we have partnered with the Community Foundation of Northern Colorado to establish an endowment where we can direct charitable donations and gifts", states Hyatt.

The Community Foundation of Northern Colorado has committed to assisting HLC with growing its assets to meet both current and future needs of the agency. The Foundation recently issued a challenge grant to HLC where they will contribute \$1 towards the endowment fund established by HLC for every \$2 raised by the organization, up to \$70,000. Under the guidelines of the challenge grant, HLC has until the end of 2008 to raise \$140,000 for its endowment fund. The Community Foundation will then add \$70,000, creating a total of \$210,000 to be placed in the HLC endowment fund.
