**NOW OPEN: A New Pathways Hospice Location in Windsor,
Community Open House and Ribbon Cutting Scheduled for September 9th**



To better serve the needs of Western Weld County, on August 2nd Pathways Hospice moved the clinically staffed Windsor Office to 1580 Main Street, Suite 2, Windsor CO 80550. Although Pathways Hospice has provided hospice care for these communities from a Windsor office for several years, many local residents were not aware of the availability of these services. The new easy-to-find office, located along Main Street just west of King Soopers, is more conveniently located with noticeable access and plenty of parking. Kathy Anderson, long-time Windsor resident and Community Relations Representative for Pathways Hospice comments on the agency's role in Windsor, "In addition to providing hospice services to the community, Pathways Hospice is committed to be an active participant in the Windsor community. We celebrate and help to foster the success of local business owners through our participation in the Windsor Chamber of Commerce as an Ambassador, welcome new teachers assigned to Re-District, participate in local activities and events." Several of the key clinical staff members on

the Windsor Team, numerous dedicated volunteers and a few members of the Board of Directors reside in Windsor and are actively involved in the community as well.

The Windsor Office provides a community resource and is available for those wishing to drop in to inquire about the hospice benefit provided by Medicare, Medicaid, and most insurance plans.
